Enjoy the cool air and get to know your park after dark! We will take a leisurely stroll along the boardwalk and listen to the sounds of the night. Meets at the Nature Center.

Tue. Dec. 31 Sat. Dec 31 New Year's Eve Hike, 5:15 pm. Maumee Bay State Park Join a Naturalist on a guided hike of the boardwalk. Enjoy the crisp winter air and listen for sounds and signs of native wildlife. Program is weather dependent. Please call 419-836-9117 for more information. Remember to dress for the weather. Meets in front of the Nature Center.

Wed. Jan 1 New Year's Day Hike, 10:00-11:30 am. Maumee Bay State Park Welcome in the New Year with morning hike on the boardwalk! Warm up inside the Nature Center after our walk at the wildlife viewing windows and enjoy our winter residents! Remember to dress for the weather and no pets, please. Meets at the Nature Center.

Fri. Jan. 10 Full Moon Walk: Wolf Moon, 5:30pm. Maumee Bay State Park Crisp, cold, and still filled with activity. We will take a leisurely stroll along the boardwalk and listen to the sounds of the night. Search for deer, racoons, and owls, and learn how wildlife prepares and survives the chilly Ohio winters! Meets at the Nature Center.

Sat. Jan 11 Winter Hike, 10:00 am. Harrison Lake State Park. Winter is here, and it doesn't mean we have to hide inside! Many of our native wildlife is still very active. Join us on a 2.5-mile hike as we welcome in the winter weather! Pleased be dressed for the weather. Meet at the Shelterhouse.

Sat. Jan 25 Winter Storybook Hike, 10:00 am Harrison Lake State Park. Cold air may be blowing, but it there is still plenty to see. Join a Naturalist on a .5 mile easy hike along the Storybook Trail as we read as we walk! Pleased be dressed for the weather. Meets by the Park Office.

Sun. Feb. 9 Full Moon Walk: Snow Moon, 6:00pm. Maumee Bay State Park This moon is usually true it its name- be prepared for snow on this hike! We will enjoy the sparkle of the snow in the moonlight as we will take a leisurely stroll along the boardwalk and listen to the sounds of the night. Meets at the Nature Center.
